We store this information securely, and we use it solely in administering this competition. We do not use it for any marketing purposes. We do not share your data with any third parties except with your further permission if your child wins, is a runner-up or is shortlisted in the competition.

You can withdraw your permission for us to keep and use this personal information at any time, and you can correct it if you think we have recorded anything incorrectly.
