A few reminders before you send us the story...

1. Please don't include your child's name, or any biographical information in the story itself or in the title so that entries can be judged anonymously.
2. Please remember to include the word count to the top right of the first page of the story.
3. If the story is typed out it can be in any font in 12pt, black. You can also write it by hand.
4. Stories must be no more than 1,500 words long.
5. And don't worry, it is not necessary to have good spelling or perfect grammar to enter – stories will be judged on originality and creativity, rather than how they are executed.
